The Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Yavapai County, hereby adopts this local administrative order to authorize court employed court security officers to be armed until an AOC approved training program is established and the opportunity to attend is available under the direction of Supreme Court Administrative Order 2019-105 paragraph 5.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority of Supreme Court Administrative Order 2017-79 section C2(i) that authorizes the Presiding Judge to establish court security policies,

IT IS ORDERED that court security officers that have demonstrated firearm proficiency and safety through previous training and experience to the satisfaction of Court Administration be allowed to remain armed until the AOC training program is established and the opportunity for each officer to attend is available.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED this policy applies to all full-time, part-time and seasonal court security officers employed by the Superior Court at all judicial branch facilities, on judicial branch grounds or where any court is convening.
