Pursuant to A.R.S. §21-102, the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of each county has the authority to limit the jury size in civil cases heard in courts of record to six jurors. The Presiding Judge may also order that a verdict may be rendered with the concurrence of all but one juror. This authority extends until January 1, 2023.

Due to the space limitations created by mandated social distancing during the COVID-19 pandemic, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a jury in any civil case tried in a court of record in the Superior Court in Yavapai County shall consist of six jurors. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED a concurrence of all but one juror shall be necessary to render a verdict. Unless otherwise ordered by the Presiding Judge, this order remains in effect until January 1, 2023.
