Whereas, the Presiding Judge of Yavapai County has administrative supervision of all the courts in the county pursuant to Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Orders 2005-32 and 2013-70;

Whereas A.R.S. §12-3201 provides that in noncriminal cases, the presiding judge of the superior court or a judge designated by the presiding judge of the superior court may designate a self-represented or pro se litigant a vexatious litigant;

Whereas, in Superior Court, the judge assigned to each case is in the best position to determine if a self-represented or pro se litigant in that particular case is a vexatious litigant;

IT IS ORDERED that in the Superior Court of Yavapai County, each judge assigned to a particular case is hereby designated as the judicial officer to make the determination as to whether a self-represented or pro se litigant is a vexatious litigant in that case.
