Pursuant to A.R.S. §38-424 and Rule 30, Rules of the Supreme Court of Arizona, any party to any action in superior court may request that any proceeding in that action be recorded by a certified reporter. The court shall grant the request if it is made at least five court days before a trial or hearing arising out of an indictment or information and a court reporter is available on the day of the trial or hearing.

Due to the shortage of certified court reporters available in the State of Arizona, the court must determine on a case-by-case basis if a court reporter is available to cover a trial or hearing. However, for purposes of judicial economy, the court does not find it necessary to submit a separate request for each case in which a court reporter will be requested.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED any law firm, agency or party to any action seeking to have a proceeding recorded by a certified court reporter may submit one request to the Superior Court in Yavapai County to cover all cases in which that law firm, agency or individual is a party or represents a party. This request may be emailed directly to Court Administration at vavapaicourtadmin@courts.az.gov, need only be submitted once per fiscal year, and can be withdrawn by the requestor at any time. The court shall grant the request if the trial or hearing

arises out of an indictment or information and a court reporter is available on the day of the trial or hearing.
