Pursuant to Rule 4.1 of the Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure, an arrested person must be promptly taken before a magistrate for an initial appearance, or within 24 hours after arrest. Additionally, pursuant to Rule 218 of the Rules of Procedure for the Juvenile Court, a juvenile must be brought before the court for a detention hearing no later than 24 hours after the filing of a petition or criminal complaint. The Clerk of Superior Court having insufficient staff to cover said proceedings during those hours other than the normal business hours of Monday through Friday, and the Presiding Judge of Yavapai County having deemed it necessary to provide such a capacity by conferring a limited court clerical authority on limited jurisdiction court personnel,

Therefore, pursuant to A.R.S. §12-283(D), IT IS ORDERED that persons employed by any limited jurisdiction court in Yavapai County for the purpose of covering weekend and holiday initial appearances and juvenile detention hearings shall be appointed as deputy court clerks by the Clerk of the Yavapai County Superior Court. These employees shall have authority as deputy clerks under A.R.S. §12-283(A), but limited to those duties necessary to efficiently cover court proceedings, including administering oaths, operating the court's recording system, preparing minute entries, and processing paperwork and documents associated with weekend and holiday initial appearances and juvenile detention hearings. This authority is further limited to
