Message from Donna McQuality, Yavapai County Clerk of the Superior Court regarding Mandatory E-Filing

The Arizona Supreme Court has issued Administrative Order 2017-117, which requires attorneys to electronically file initiation and post-initiation civil case documents when filing into the Yavapai County Superior Court and Mohave County Superior Court. This requirement becomes effective December 1, 2017. Though it is not mandatory, self-represented litigants may also file electronically. Procedural requirements described in Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2016-20 and Yavapai County Administrative Order 2017-17 shall apply to all civil case documents.

Currently civil case e-Filing is supported through eFileAZ and AZTurboCourt in the Superior Courts for Yavapai County and Mohave County and through AZTurbo Court for the Superior Court in Maricopa and Pima Counties.
