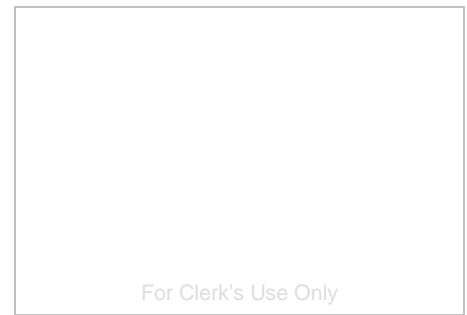

THE COURT ORDERS:

The Clerk of the Superior Court of Arizona in Yavapai County shall issue a "Warrant to Take Physical Custody of Child(ren)" under seal of this Court, to the Sheriff of Yavapai County or any other law enforcement officer:

POSSESSION OF THE MINOR CHILD(REN): The Sheriff of Yavapai County or any other law enforcement officer shall immediately take possession of the minor child(ren) named above and deliver him/her to: Child Protective Services of the Arizona Department of Economic Security or such other Arizona agency as may properly care for the child(ren) **OR**

ENTRY PRIVATE PROPERTY: The Sheriff of Yavapai County or any other law enforcement officer is authorized to enter private property to take physical custody of the child(ren) by forcible entry at any hour.
