CHECKLIST

USE THE FORMS AND INSTRUCTIONS in this packet only if the following factors apply to your situation:

- ✓ You have been appointed guardian and/or conservator for a minor, AND
- ✓ The minor reached age 18, or there is another good reason to stop the guardianship and/or conservatorship, AND
- ✓ You want to be discharged as guardian and/or conservator, AND/OR
- ✓ You want a court order to release restricted funds to the minor, OR
- ✓ You are the parent of the minor and want to withdraw your consent to the appointment of the current guardian and/or conservator.

IF YOU ARE NOT SURE THESE FORMS ARE RIGHT FOR YOUR SITUATION, CONTACT AN ATTORNEY FOR HELP AND ADVICE.

READ ME: It is very important for you to know that when you sign a court document, you may be helping or hurting your court case. Before you sign any court document, or get involved with a court case, it is important that you see a lawyer to make sure you are doing the right thing.
