## TEMPORARY AND/OR EMERGENCY APPOINTMENT OF GUARDIAN OF A MINOR

## **CHECKLIST**

USE THE FORMS AND INSTRUCTIONS in this packet only if the following factors apply to your situation:

- ✓ You want the Court to appoint a guardian for one or more persons under the age of 18 on a temporary or emergency basis for a period of not more than 6 months.\*
- ✓ The minor lives in Yavapai County,
- ✓ The person who will serve as guardian is not one of the parents.
- You believe that the minor(s) needs to have a guardian temporarily and/or immediately.\*
- ✓ If you are applying for temporary or emergency guardianship for more than one child, they have the same parents.\*\*
  - \* If the need for the guardianship will continue for more than 6 months, you will need to petition for regular guardianship.
  - \*\* If there are multiple children and they do not have the same father and mother, you must file a separate case for each set of parents.

## DO NOT USE THESE FORMS AND INSTRUCTIONS if the following factors apply to your situation:

- You want the Court to appoint a temporary/emergency guardian for an ADULT OR
- ★ The minor lives outside of Yavapai County

IF YOU ARE NOT SURE THESE FORMS ARE RIGHT FOR YOUR SITUATION, CONTACT AN ATTORNEY FOR HELP AND ADVICE.

**READ ME:** It is very important for you to know that when you sign a court document, you may be helping or hurting your court case. Before you sign any court document, or get involved with a court case, it is important that you see a lawyer to make sure you are doing the right thing.
