**OBJECTING TO THE TRANSFER OF YOUR CASE TO ANOTHER COUNTY**

**CHECKLIST**

**USE THE FORMS AND INSTRUCTIONS** in this packet only if the following factors apply to your situation:

- ✓ The other party in your case has filed a Request for Transfer of your case to another county in Arizona for the purpose of establishing child support or modifying (changing) the current child support amount **AND**
- ✓ You have been served with a copy of the Request for Transfer and copies of other documents the party filed to establish or modify child support **AND**
- ✓ You object to the transfer of your case because: The child(ren) do(es) not live in the other county; **OR** The child(ren) do(es) not live out of state **OR** The child(ren) do(es) reside(s) out of state but the requesting party does not live in the other county **AND**
- ✓ You want a hearing to tell the Court why you object to the transfer.

**DO NOT USE THE FORMS AND INSTRUCTIONS** in this packet if the following factors apply to your situation:

- ✓ You do not object to the Request for Transfer **OR**
- ✓ You do not object to the Request for Transfer **AND**
- ✓ You do object to the child support request filed along with the Request for Transfer: either a Request to Establish Child Support or a Request to Modify Child Support. You must use other forms to respond to the child support request.

**IF YOU ARE NOT SURE WHETHER THESE FORMS APPLY TO YOUR SITUATION,  
CONSULT A LAWYER FOR HELP.**

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Cases can only be transferred for purposes of child support establishment or modification. If other issues arise after the case is transferred, they will be handled in the new county.
